1. Vintage 2005 54.99 **44.99**
A total gem unlocked as a special parcel for festive celebrations. Toasty, fresh and complex all in one go.

France – Domaine Ferret, Burgundy

2. Pouilly Fuisse 2017 29.99 **23.99**
A nose which is rich and subtle, with fresh notes of white flowers. Nicely rounded and very fresh with good structure and a nice palate.

France – Domaine Romy, Beaujolais

3. Vieilles Vignes 'Les Pierres Dorées' 2017 10.99 **8.99**
Domaine Romy is no ordinary Beaujolais, the vines are least 50 years old and give tiny yields that are meticulously hand-harvested and de-stemmed. It's vinified as a red Burgundy without whole grape bunch fermentation of Beaujolais, avoiding the juicy fruit flavours and thinner textures.

South - Africa - Kleine Zalze

Kleine Zalze is a family owned winery situated in the heart of the Cape Winelands. Winemaking has taken place there on a small scale since 1695 but it was in 1996, when Kobus Basson and his family purchased the property, that the modern Kleine Zalze was born.

4. Vineyard Select Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 14.99 **12.99**

New Zealand – Vidal, Marlborough

Our overriding wine style is one of elegance. We look for underlying complexity, fine structure, good natural acidity and least not concentration of flavour, but not in a big, over powering way. Our wines tend to be better food wines because they don't dominate food, rather compliment.

4. Serge Dagueneau Pouilly Fume 2018 15.99 **14.39**
Serge's daughter, Valérie, looks after their 15 hectares of vineyards and makes the wine with a view to preserving as much terroir in the wines as possible. Their vines are planted on a unique concoction of clay/limestone 'Terres Blanches' over kimmeridgean clay and crushed oyster shells.

France - Red

5. Ch Unang LA Source Rouge 2015 - organic 12.99 **11.69**
Grapes: Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault. Yields of 25 hl/hectare, hand-harvested. The highest vines (350m altitude) of Unang are used for reds. This wine brings together the sweetness of Grenache produced on our sandy soils supporting the concentration of Syrah flourishing on our limestone/clay parcels at the top of the hill, which benefit from better exposure.

6. Domaine Pegau, Plan Pegau NV 13.49 **11.99**
From the Southern Rhone. A delicious wine, plenty of meaty black fruits, herbs and leather with richness and depth on the palate. A perfect mid-week quaffer that has character.

7. Château Haut Plantey 2015, St Emilion Grand Cru 27.99 **24.99**
Under the direction of Michel Boutet quality has surged in the last 10 years and this St. Emilion Grand Cru Chateaux is now producing wines of intensity and elegance. In this age of vinous inflation they are remarkably good value.

8. Siebritskloof David & Nadia Pinotage 2017 20.99 **17.99**
Arguably the best Pinotage in South Africa, this charming expression is turning heads and bringing people back to this unloved grape variety. Delicate red fruit, raspberry and cherry with an earthy undertone, aromatic, saline and rocky with a firm but fresh structure. Just 12% alcohol and picked early to retain as much acidity as possible.

Everything you could ever want from an entry-level Malbec, and more! That's how we feel about this cracking little wine. Why is it so good, so much better than other wines in its price bracket? A couple of things: First, it's made by Mauricio Lorca, which is always a good start! Second, the fruit is all from Mauricio's own high altitude vineyards in Vista Flores in the Uco Valley, and the wine is bottled at source at his winery in Mendoza.

5. Anubis Malbec 2018 11.99 **10.79**

The fruit for this very tasty little 100% Malbec comes from Luján de Cuyo at around 950 metres above sea level. The secret to its success is its simplicity, its soft texture, its attractive fruity aromatics with a hint of violets. The wine spends 6 months in used oak before release to give just a subtle kiss of vanilla.

6. Vallisto Barbera 2018 17.99 **15.99**

From grapes grown at 1,900 MASL on the western slope of Cafayate Valley, this wine will bring a beaming smile to the most miserable of faces! The nose is an explosion of beautifully pure, sweet aromas of raspberry ripple, blackberries and blueberry pie.

7. Catalpa Assemblage 2016 19.99 **17.99**

"The Atamisque reds are distinguished by their perfume and fine-grained tannins. This blend of Cabernet Franc with 20% Merlot and 10% each of Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon is no exception, featuring subtle oak, grassy yet ripe flavours, bright acidity and a long, tapering palate."

2. L'Intruse Chardonnay Vin de France (Sancerre) 14.99 **12.99**

Nestled within the heart of Sancerre lies a rogue parcel of Chardonnay. Planted on a band of pure silex in the commune of Ste-Gemme-en-Sancerrois in the mid 1990's, these grapes were only ever destined for sparkling wine production. Now that the vines have reached 20 years of age, the Berthier family decided to see how these grapes would perform as a still wine.

3. Coteaux du Giennois 2018 Dom de L'oselier 14.99 **12.99**

There has been a fair influx of producers arriving from Sancerre and Pouilly, confident that they can increase their production in other neighbouring appellations. Everything is planted on the band of silex which runs through the appellation. Some of the Sauvignon vines are over 100 years old and are bush vines which means that they need to be hand-harvested.

4. Gamay IGP Loire 2018 Domaine Moulin Camus 9.99 **8.99**

Planted on a slope of pure schist. Mineral and taut, this is not some mild-mannered Beaujolais alternative.

5. Chinon 'Logis de la Bouchardiere' 2018 12.99 **11.69**

Bruno represents the sixth generation of his family dating back to 1840-1850. This cuvee is fuller, rounder and very aromatic giving great pleasure to lovers of young wines with its remarkable elegance.

South Africa

6. Roussanne 2017 The Foundry 14.99 **12.99**

The Foundry works closely with a handful of growers across the Cape to secure grapes from sites which are best suited to each of the varieties. All are vinified, matured and bottled at the Meerlust cellar in Stellenbosch.

7. 'Saskia' 2015 Miles Mossop 18.99 **16.99**

This is a blended dry white wine comprised of 73% Chenin blanc, 18% Viognier and 9% Clairette Blanche. A perfect accompaniment to Lobster Bisque, Seafood Paella, Sushi or an mildly spicy dish.

This example, where the grape must (juice) is partially fermented to retain a fresh, fruity sweetness, has ripe, refreshing flavours of raspberries, blackberries and blackcurrants.
